Year 11 Post-Easter Arrangements

I am writing to inform you of the arrangements for Year 11 following their return from the Easter holidays.

Phase 1 – Monday 30th April

From this date onwards, students do not need to attend morning registration. This allows them the extra time to either come in a bit later or to use it for revision. Their attendance (and any lateness) will be recorded from their Period 1 lesson. They are expected to be at their Period 1 lesson by 8:50am. They will still be expected to attend **all lessons**. If there are any lessons at this point where they have completed all forms of formal assessment, they will use the room and time, with teacher supervision, to study independently for their other subjects. Similarly, they will still be expected to attend their Personal Development lesson, but they will use it for supervised study.

Celebration Assembly – Friday 11th May

This will be Year 11's final assembly together, in which they should receive any purchased hoodies and yearbooks. This is where they will be able to sign shirts and yearbooks. They will also be receiving an electronic tap-in card. Year 11 will be expected to use these cards to sign in and out every day. It is very important that students remember to do this in the interest of safeguarding. If they lose this card, a replacement will be £10. If they are staying on at Bullers Wood Sixth Form, these cards will be carried through to Year 12 and Year 13. Following this assembly, Year 11 will leave school around lunch time.

Phase 2 – Monday 14th May

From this date onwards, Year 11 will only be expected to **attend the lessons of subjects for which they still have exams to sit**. If they no longer have exams for a subject, they may use a study room or, if they no longer have lessons that they need to attend for the rest of the day, they may go home early, as long as they tap out to inform us. Similarly, if they have no necessary lessons in the mornings, they can come in late for their first necessary lesson. They will not need to attend Personal Development, but may use the room for private study. I would just like to reiterate that, unless they have a formal exam at the same time, students are expected to consistently attend the lessons that they still have exams for. We will continue to monitor their attendance closely. Year 11 will be permitted to wear their school hoodies over their normal uniform from this date onwards, apart from when sat in an examination.

Arrangements for the cut-off point for Core P.E. attendance will be confirmed soon. Students should continue to attend Core P.E. lessons as normal until otherwise stated.
