

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS – SEPTEMBER 2019

<b>A level Courses</b>	<b>Five GCSEs at grade 5 or above.</b> Additional subject specific requirements are shown below.
<b>Vocational Courses</b>	<b>Five GCSEs at grade 4 or above including English Language and Mathematics.</b> Additional subject specific requirements are shown below.

Students who do not achieve a Grade 5 in English Language or Mathematics GCSE will resit these subjects.

### Subject Specific Requirements

<b>A Level Courses</b>	<b>Additional Subject Specific Requirements</b>
Art	Grade 5 or above in Art.
Biology *	Grade 6-6 or above in Combined Science, or a Grade 6 or above in Biology for those studying the Triple Award. Grade 5 or above in Mathematics and English Language or Literature. A Grade 6 in Mathematics is preferred.
Business Studies *	Grade 5 in English Language and Mathematics. Grade 5 in Business Studies if studied.
Chemistry *	Grade 6-6 or above in Combined Science, or a Grade 6 or above in Chemistry for those studying the Triple Award. Grade 5 or above in English Language or Literature. A grade 6 in Mathematics is preferred.
Computer Science	Grade 5 or above in Mathematics or a Science subject. Grade 5 or above in Computing if studied.
Dance	Grade 5 or above in English Language and Grade 5 in Dance if studied. A proven interest and ability in Dance.
Design and Technology: Product Design	Grade 5 or above in Technology.
Design and Technology: Fashion & Textiles	Grade 5 or above in Technology.
Drama & Theatre Studies	Grade 5 or above in English Language and Grade 5 in Drama if studied. A proven interest and ability in practical Drama.
Economics *	Grade 5 or above in English Language and Mathematics.
English Language	Grade 5 or above in English Language and English Literature.
English Literature	Grade 5 or above in English Language and English Literature.
French	Grade 5 or above in French.
Geography *	Grade 5 or above in English Language and Mathematics. Grade 5 or above in Geography if taken.
German	Grade 5 or above in German.
Government and Politics	Grade 5 or above in English Language and English Literature and Grade 5 in History if taken. An interest in current affairs is helpful.
History	Grade 5 or above in English Language and English Literature and Grade 5 in History if taken. An interest in current affairs is helpful.
Italian	Grade 5 or above in Italian.
Mathematics	Grade 6 or above in Mathematics. Students will be asked to sit a diagnostic test in July to inform further advice and guidance as to suitability for the course.
Mathematics (Further)	Grade 7 or above in Mathematics and must also study A level Mathematics.

Media Studies	Grade 5 or above in English Language and Mathematics. Grade 5 in Media if studied.
Music	Grade 5 or above in Music and Grade 4 on principal instrument.
Philosophy	Grade 5 or above in English Language and Mathematics. Grade 5 in Religious Studies if studied.
Photography	Grade 5 or above in Art if studied or evidence of ability.
Physical Education	Grade 5 or above in a Science subject and Grade 5 in PE GCSE if studied. A background in Sport and evidence of practical will also be required.
Physics *	Grade 6-6 or above in Combined Science, or a Grade 6 or above in Physics for those studying the Triple Award. Grade 6 in Mathematics and Grade 5 in English Language or Literature. It is recommended that students study A level Mathematics.
Psychology *	Grade 5 in English Language and Mathematics and a Grade 5 in a Science subject.
Religious Studies	Grade 5 or above in English Language and Grade 5 in RS if studied.
Sociology	Grade 5 or above in English Language and English Literature.
Spanish	Grade 5 or above Spanish.

\* Students on these courses will be expected to undertake additional Mathematics as directed by the Department, unless they are studying A Level Mathematics or achieved Grade 7 or higher in GCSE Mathematics.
