



Contact Gateway before 8:30am <u>each</u> day your child is absent.




## PE Uniform


#### **Detentions**






## **Valuables**

During PE lessons students will be given the opportunity to hand valuables such as phones and watches in for safe keeping in a locked office, it is the student's responsibility to hand them in.




