Re: A Level PE Trip - Altitude Centre - Monday 29th April 2024

The PE Department is pleased to be able to offer A Level PE students the opportunity to visit the Altitude Centre, 50 Gun Street, London E1 6AH on Monday 29th April 2024. This trip will help to develop students understanding of simulated altitude training, explain the underlying theory of hypoxia and different hypoxic training methods, and translate the theory into practice that they have been studying applied anatomy and physiology for paper 2 examination.
