Proposed Geography Tour to Iceland – Monday 21st – Friday 25th October 2024

This letter is to inform you about a planned visit to Iceland scheduled to take place in the <u>October Half Term in 2024</u>. The visit is open to Geography students who will then be in Years 11-13 and will be of interest to students who like to visit unusual and interesting places. Visits will be made to Keflavik-Reykjanes Peninsula, the Blue Lagoon, a glacial walk and various other sites of Geographical significance including beautiful waterfalls, craters and a Lava Show.

The cost of the visit is £1,660; the cost is based on 30 paying passengers. The cost includes:

- return flights from Heathrow
- four nights' accommodation at various locations, (students will be accommodated in multi-bedded rooms with shared facilities)
- full board (from arrival)
- activities and visits as described above
- full insurance cover

Parents will be responsible for arranging and paying for transport to and from Heathrow Airport. Students will need to bring food/drinks for the day of departure (or money to purchase) until the evening meal at the hotel. A small amount of spending money may be taken for gifts/extra but please note that it can be expensive in Iceland. Students will need clothing/footwear suitable for a cold environment (a recommended kit list will be circulated prior to the trip).

Places will be allocated by ballot. In order to enter your son/daughter into the ballot for a place on the trip please consent via Gateway (under payments) by midnight on **Wednesday 6**th **December 2023.** Please do not consent for a place in the ballot if you will not accept a place if offered.

Students will then be selected randomly from the ballot and you will be notified on **Thursday** 7th **December 2023** if your son/daughter has been successful in being allocated a place on the trip. In order to secure the place a deposit of £160 must then be paid by midnight on **Sunday 10th December 2023**. We appreciate that this is a quick turnaround for the deposit payment, however this is to ensure that we obtain the best flight price. The deposit is non-refundable unless there is insufficient interest for the trip to go ahead the deposit payments will be refunded.

Further instalments will then be due as follows:-

- 29th February 2024 £250
- 31st March 2024 £250

<u>Travel requirements</u>

Passport: A full valid passport is needed for the trip (Valid until at least 01.02.2024). A copy of this passport will be requested by the school by email prior to the trip.

Visas: If the student is not a UK or EU National parents are responsible for obtaining and paying for any visa(s) required for travel to Iceland.

These requirements are obviously subject to change and parents will be updated of any changes nearer the time of the trip.

By paying the deposit you are giving consent for the trip and you are agreeing to the following:-

- 1. Your son/daughter will have a valid passport and will meet any travel entry requirements at the time of the trip.
- 2. Both you and the student agree to the terms set out in the Code of Conduct for Students on School Trips, which is available on the school website under Parents/Trips & Visits.
- 3. You will advise the school of any changes to your emergency contact details prior to the trip departing.
- 4. You will advise the school office via office@bwsgirls.org of any changes in your son/daughter's medical condition(s) (if any) between now and the date of the trip, or if you have any other concerns regarding their ability to participate.
- 5. You give permission for the student to receive any first aid or medical treatment that may be required during the trip.
