The Art Department would like to offer your daughter/son the opportunity to visit the Entangled Pasts Exhibition at The Royal Academy of Arts, Burlington House, Piccadilly, London W1J 0BD on Thursday 29th February 2024 in order to support their classwork and exam.

Students should meet in Inglewood at 8.30am where they will be registered and briefed for the day. They will then walk to Chislehurst Station to catch the train to Victoria and then a tube to Green Park.
