Y9 TRIP TO THE OBSERVATORY, SCIENCE CENTRE AT HERSTMONCEUX

A trip to The Observatory at Herstmonceux been arranged for Year 9. This trip will take place on Monday 26th September 2022. Students will be given a tour of the Observatory and talks on several telescopes, as well as being involved in a series of scientific problem solving team activities.

Students should arrive at school by 8.00am for registration (behind Inglewood) and will travel to Herstmonceux by coach, returning to school at approximately 3.30pm. Coaches must leave the venue promptly, any additional transport costs incurred if a student does not return to the coach at the time requested by staff may be charged to parents.

Students should wear sensible clothing for an outdoor day, including waterproofs if the weather forecast requires it. Students should bring a packed lunch and drinks. They may get an opportunity to visit the gift shop but we request that they do not bring more than £10 to spend.

The cost of the trip is **£25** which covers the entrance and coach travel costs. Payment should be made via School Gateway, by **Friday 16th September at the latest**. If you have any difficulty in paying this, please contact myself or Mrs Johnson by email as soon as possible – SJohnson@bwsmat.org as no student in the group will be omitted for financial reasons, however without adequate support the trip may not go ahead.

If your child receives Pupil Premium funding then the cost of this trip will be covered by the school, however you must log onto School Gateway (Under Payments) to give your permission for them to attend the trip. **Your consent must be recorded via Gateway or by email to SJohnson@bwsmat.org by Friday 16th September at the latest to secure a place.** Please also note that a packed lunch will be provided for those students in receipt of free school meals.

If your child has a music lesson on the day of the visit they should notify their peripatetic teacher in advance. We also request that students do not bring valuable articles with them. Staff cannot be held responsible for any loss of personal belongings.
